CHOOSING YOUR CHRISTMAS TREE

DOUGLAS-FIR

- blue green in color and are approximately 1 to 1.5 inches in length.
- Douglas-fir needles radiate in all directions from the branch.
- When crushed, these needles have a sweet fragrance.

BALSAM FIR

- These soft needles are dark green to These needles are .75 to 1.5 inches in length and last a very long time.
 - This tree has a dark-green appearance and retains its pleasing fragrance throughout the Christmas season.

YOUNG ADULTS aged 19 to 30 are invited to join their peers for a performance of Scrooge The Musical at NACC.


