TEAM completed 88 courier
assignments and 74 recycling and

The Business Services Team operates through the YKACL Skills Training and Community Inclusion Service for adults with intellectual disabilities (ST&CI).

The Business Services Team offers:

Team revenue is paid in wage to the clients providing the service.

THIRTY-EIGHT CUSTOMERS hired The Odd Job Squad in November, providing temporary work for 13 clients.

The variety of jobs included snow shoveling, stacking wood, pet waste removal, deliveries and dump runs.

The Odd Job Squad is designed to assist underemployed individuals who self-identify with a disability to derive a small income from one-time or short-term work while they search for permanent employment.




